

## Baden-Württemberg STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

### Guidelines for the Scholarship Report

The following gives you information on the minimum formal and content requirements of the report you should write about your study programme in Baden-Württemberg. You may of course add elements at your own discretion.

#### Form al Aspects:

- Maximum 5 pages in Din A4 format
- Front cover with personal data and information about your study abroad (name / given name / contact details / home university / host university / area of study / degree programme / semester or year of study / duration of scholarship)
- Two hardcopies / digital version (optional)
- Permission to publish on the Foundation's home page
- Submit to the Baden-Württemberg Ministry of Science, Research and Art, Stuttgart via the German university
- Submission date: no later than one month after the end of the study abroad period.

#### Content:

- Preparation for study abroad (e.g. language course, cultural information, bureaucratic measures .... )
- Study abroad (university, courses, internships, lectures, university system ....); points of comparison
- Sojourn in the host country (personal experiences and impressions, life outside the university, transfer, „take-away value“,...)
- Participation in conferences, workshops, ...
- Personal assessment of sojourn at the host university and in the host country
