^{*}The lecture period is a little shorter and varies from year to year.

Normally, the lecture period in the winter semester starts in the middle of October and ends in the beginning of February. There is a short winter break without lectures between Christmas and January 6th. The examination weeks take place from the beginning to the middle of February.

After a short spring break, the lecture period in the summer semester starts approx. in mid-April and ends in the end of July. There is an excursion week after Whitsunday where no lectures are held. The examination weeks take place from the end of July to the beginning or middle of August.

Nomination & Application Process

- 1. Interested students have to be nominated by their home university via incomings@ph-ludwigsburg.de until December 1st/ May 1st.
- 2. The registration and application then proceed online via MoveOn. A link with access information will be sent out to the nominated students.
- 3. Students who submit their complete application until December 15th/ May 15th will be admitted and receive a Letter of Acceptance shortly after.
- 4. Erasmus+ exchange students who are coming to LUE have to use the Online Learning Agreement (OLA). Detailed instructions are available on our <u>website</u>.
- 5. Course registration can be done in mid-February until April respectively mid-August until October.

Preconditions:

- 1. Existence of a valid agreement between the home university and LUE.
- 2. Required language skills: German at least level B1.2 and/or English level B2 (to be officially documented upon request).
- 3. Required ECTS:
 - Erasmus+ students please check the regulations for the ECTS of their home university.
 - Students who receive a scholarship from LUE are required to earn at least 20 ECTS.

Course Catalogue

Ludwigsburg University of Education offers many courses related to education. Exchange students can choose their courses from the entire course catalogue and are not restricted to the courses of a specific faculty or study programme. The course catalogue varies every semester, but for a winter semester it is comparable to the last winter semester's catalogue respectively the course catalogue of the last summer semester is comparable to the next summer semester. The new course catalogue for the summer semester is published in mid-February, for the new winter semester in mid-August.

The general course catalogue is available via LSF through this link. You can change the semester and language in the upper right corner. Courses that are taught in English can be found here. Please note, that except for those "Courses taught in English" all other courses will mainly be taught in German. It is mandatory for incoming students, whose mother tongue is not German, to attend a German language course. We offer three different levels (beginners, intermediate, advanced). Students receive 6 ECTS for this course.

In order to be able to present exchange students a reliable offering of courses taught in English, we have developed the International Course Package "Diversity, Inclusion and Sustainability in Teacher Education". In addition to these courses, non-German speakers can take language courses and practical speaking exercises.
