*The lecture period is a little shorter and varies from year to year.

Normally, the lecture period in the winter semester starts in the middle of October and ends in the beginning of February. There is a short winter break without lectures between Christmas and January 6th. The examination weeks take place from the beginning to the middle of February.

After a short spring break, the lecture period in the summer semester starts approx. in mid-April and ends in the end of July. There is an excursion week after Whitsunday where no lectures are held. The examination weeks take place from the end of July to the beginning or middle of August.

❖ Nomination & Application Process

1. Interested students have to be nominated by their home university via incomings@ph-ludwigsburg.de until November 1st/ May 1st.
2. The registration and application then proceed online via MoveOn. A link with access information will be sent out to the nominated students.
3. Students who submit their complete application until November 15th/ May 15th will be admitted and receive a Letter of Acceptance shortly after.
4. Erasmus+ exchange students who are coming to LUE have to use the Online Learning Agreement (OLA). Detailed instructions are available on our [website](#).
5. Course registration can be done in mid-February until April respectively mid-August until October.

Requirements:

For the nomination:

1. Existence of a valid agreement between the home university and LUE.
2. Nominated student must be enrolled as a student at our partner university.
3. Required language skills: German at least level B1.2 and/or English level B2 (to be officially documented upon request).

During the stay:

1. Having health insurance is obligatory for the enrolment at the university. European students can use their EHIC.
2. Paying the semester fee (social fee for cheaper Mensa food, consulting services etc., no tuition fee) of currently approx. 100 EUR for exchange students from our partner universities and approx. 200 EUR for free mover.
3. Required ECTS: We expect exchange students to study full-time, that means to take courses with at least 20 ECTS per semester.
Please also note the following:
 - Erasmus+ students please check the regulations for the ECTS of their home university.
 - Students who receive a scholarship from LUE are required to earn at least 20 ECTS.

❖ Course Catalogue

Ludwigsburg University of Education offers many **courses related to education**.

International exchange students can either **put together their own schedule**, choosing courses from the entire course catalogue across all faculties, or **enrol in one of our course packages** offered during the summer semester. The course catalogue varies every semester, but for a winter semester it is comparable to the last winter semester's catalogue respectively the course catalogue of the last summer semester is comparable to the next summer semester. The new course catalogue for the summer semester is published in mid-February, for the new winter semester in mid-August.

Please note, that except for those "Courses taught in English" all other courses will mainly be taught in German. It is mandatory for incoming students, whose mother tongue is not German, to attend a German language course. We offer three different levels (beginners, intermediate, advanced). Students receive 6 ECTS for this course.

In addition to taking courses, doing an internship at a school is also possible. German language skills are often a requirement for an internship. Internships in English can also be possible, but normally only in the subject English.
