❖ Nomination & Application Process

1. Interested students have to be nominated by their home university via incomings@ph-ludwigsburg.de until December 1st/ May 1st.
2. The registration and application then proceed online via MoveOn. A link with access information will be sent out to the nominated students.
3. Students who submit their complete application until December 15th/ May 15th will be admitted and receive a Letter of Acceptance shortly after.
4. Erasmus+ exchange students who are coming to LUE have to use the Online Learning Agreement (OLA). A detailed instruction is available on our website: <https://www.ph-ludwigsburg.de/en/studies/international-exchange-students/online-learning-agreement-ola>

5. Enrollment in classes will take place after the arrival of the international students in Ludwigsburg.

Preconditions:

1. Existence of a valid agreement between the home university and LUE.
2. Required language skills: German at least level B1.2 and/or English level B2 (to be officially documented upon request).
3. Required ECTS:
 - Erasmus+ students please check the regulations for the ECTS of their home university.
 - Students who receive a scholarship of the LUE are required to earn at least 20 ECTS.
