### a.) Presentation

#### Content:

|             | criteria  |
|-------------|---|
| <b>pass</b> | topic is comprehensively dealt with, enough information, recognizable structure                         |
| <b>fail</b> | hardly informative, hardly recognizable structure, unprepared, incomprehensible / incoherent statements |

#### Media and Presentation Techniques:

|             | criteria  |
|-------------|---|
| <b>pass</b> | adequately presented, captivated the audience, media or other presentation aids support comprehension                             |
| <b>fail</b> | poorly presented, hardly captivated the audience, media or other presentation aids used in isolation and without a clear function |

#### Language:

|             | criteria   |
|-------------|--|
| <b>pass</b> | speaks fluently (only with occasional hesitations) with minor mistakes, presents mostly freely with only the help of key words, can react to questions |
| <b>fail</b> | speaks haltingly, makes rudimentary language mistakes, reproduces a memorized text, has major problems reacting to questions                           |

### b.) Written reflection

#### Content:

|             | criteria   |
|-------------|--|
| <b>pass</b> | shows ability to reflect the project (e.g. reflects product and process, mentions what was bad / good, mentions alternatives, explains personal learning progress, reflects whether it was a real project) |
| <b>fail</b> | shows almost no ability to reflect the project (e.g. just describes what has happened )  |

#### Language:

|             | criteria  |
|-------------|---|
| <b>pass</b> | varied lexis, predominantly grammatically correct, varied sentence structure, predominantly correct spelling                                |
| <b>fail</b> | simple lexis with mistakes, severe grammatical mistakes, only simple sentence structure, bad spelling, isolated sentences, incomprehensible |

#### Layout:

|             | criteria   |
|-------------|--|
| <b>pass</b> | attractively presented and easy to navigate                          |
| <b>fail</b> | not attractively presented (e.g. dog-ears, stains, no paragraphs...) |
