What?

Teaching a compact seminar (in English) of 28 hours at LUE (1-4 weeks)**.

Remuneration?

Stipend of 952 € (approx. 1.132 US \$) and free accommodation in one of our guest apartments on campus.

Which subjects?

Generally, LUE welcomes applications for all subject areas being offered at LUE (see [here](#) for more information about our profile). However, LUE especially encourages applications in the field of **English** (especially linguistics), **Educational Science**, **Political Science**, **Geography**, **History**, **Physical Education**, and **Music Studies**. Due to our bilingual teacher training program we have a special need of course offers taught in English in these subject areas***.

Faculty members/teaching staff of our partner universities.

When?

Summer semester 2019: April - July *or* winter semester 2019/20: October - February.

Please send an e-mail to your International Office, outlining a possible topic for your seminar and the preferred timeframe for your stay. Please also attach a short CV. Your International Office will forward your information to us.

* Please note that our grants are limited to ten per academic year. We primarily invite lecturers from our partner universities in the US and Australia. Be advised that we can usually only fund one grant per partner institution.

** The teaching design for a one-week compact seminar is only possible in following weeks: April 1 - April 6, 2019 *or* June 6 - June 10, 2019 *or* October 7 - October 11, 2019. The teaching design of a 3- or 4-week compact seminar is possible throughout the complete semester. You will be teaching on Fridays/Saturdays over 3-4 weekends in order to allow our students to integrate your course into their regular schedules.
